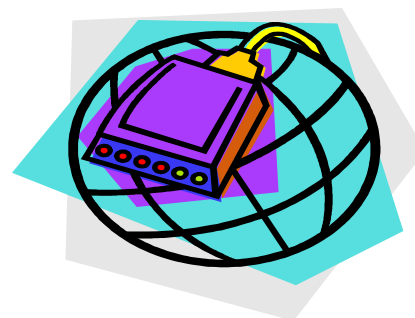
Millers Island Charity Casino Night
