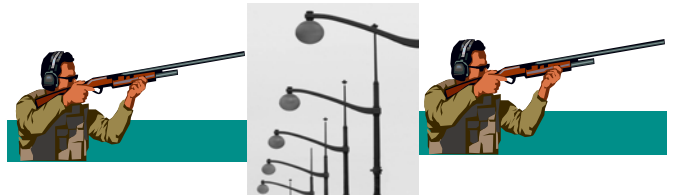

DWI arrest here in Millers Island

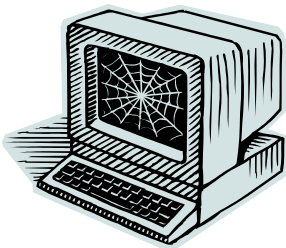
