## Mosquito Treatment



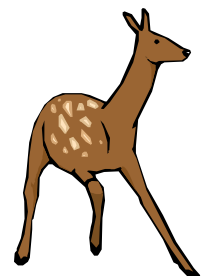
The mosquito trucks will be out this summer to spray our community on Thursday evenings, around 8:00PM, however some things you need to know. They can't spray if you are outside in the yard, if it is raining, below 60 degrees or hotter than 80 degrees. So if none of these conditions exist the mosquito truck can and will spray in our area on Thursday nights.

Let's help out with mosquito control and not leave standing water in bird baths, baby pools, buckets, planters, etc. Mosquitoes lay their larvae in water so you don't want to have mosquito breeding areas in your yard.

## Deer Crossing signs

I believe most of us have seen the deer crossing Millers Island Rd., or perhaps in Bauers Farm or crossing Northpoint Rd. It was suggested that I call Baltimore County to request deer crossing signage. I did, I was told that there have only been (4) reports for dead deer or deer related accidents in the last 6 years and this does not justify installing deer crossing signage. Yes, I called the same department that the state park would contact and the answer would be the same. So just be aware that deer are in our area, and be cautious while driving.
