3rd Street Canal

This is one project that we just can't seem to get up and running. The ideal answer is to extend the storm pipe and fill the canal in. However, this is not legal due to rules and regulations with all three levels of our government, Federal, State and County. So we have to work within the legal scope laid out before us. At this time according to representatives from these three levels of government the best answer we have is the one currently being proposed, which is a wetland enhancement project. The Millers Island community Association has obtained permits from both the Federal and State government to go forward with this proposal. At the present time one of the adjacent property owners is not satisfied with the proposal and believe they can obtain permits to build a bulkhead on their side of the canal. Until and unless this property owner gives Baltimore County the permission to go forward with this proposal, as well as permission to access the canal from their property (vacant lot) this project is on hold. This is unfortunate and causing more work then necessary, however, as President of the Association I will write a letter to M.D.E requesting that our permit date be extended, keeping our permit valid and in good standing.

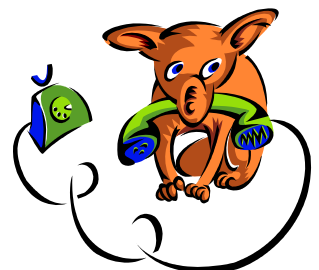
Sprucing up our playground.
