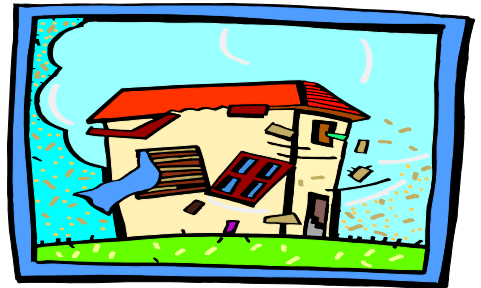

Pre-planning for flooding, been there done that

Let try to be one up on the situation, best way I know to do that is prepare. Here are the two latest tid bits on this topic. A new county ordinance or law is being introduced making it mandatory that all fuel tanks be anchored to the ground if you reside in a flood plain. Well I don't have to remind anyone that we do live in a flood plain so be aware that your fuel tanks (oil or propane) have to be anchored to the ground. Fuel companies are being directed not to re-fill tanks that are not properly secured.

Due to the flooding situation even the small events that we seem to have here on the Island from time to time made me realize that maybe we need to have some preplanning done. To start I've called the Principal of Edgemere Elementary school, Mr. Robert Sindly and obtained pre-authorization for any Millers Island resident to relocate your vehicle on the Edgemere Elementary school lot in the event of flooding. This procedure can only be used when school is not in session. So I'd recommend you take advantage of this gracious consideration to prevent your car from being a victim



of a flood. I'm also organizing a Millers Island Emergency Preparedness Committee. So far I have 3 sector captains and I need 2 more, one from Chesapeake Ave and the other from Millers Island Blvd. Call Bernice (410) 978-1920, if your interested.
