### DISASTER RELIEF DUMPSTERS ON LYNCH POINT FEBRUARY 21st

Baltimore County is providing cleanup dumpsters to waterfront communities devastated by last September's hurricane and flood. The dumpsters will arrive at approximately 7:00 am and will be placed on Grace Road at the Lynch Point Ball Field.
